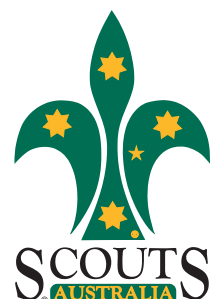

Contingent Leader's Message

It is hard to believe that we are now less than 12 months away from the 24th World Scout Jamboree! Since our last newsletter, my team and I have been busy getting the contingent into full swing.

Our preparations for America have been accelerating in recent months with several significant payments having been paid by the Contingent. I am pleased to announce that Qantas is now confirmed for providing all of our flights on our journey to the United States of America. This will include both our domestic connections in Australia and our international flights to the United States of America. We are still working with other airlines in America to secure the internal flights.

Many of our other tour plans in America are also in the final stages of confirmation and my team and I look forward to sharing more details of these activities as we get closer to our departure.

I would like to thank everyone for their cooperation with keeping their payments up to date. This ensures we can make payments as required on time and in full. As you can imagine, there is a huge amount of preparation involved to support a Contingent of this size. Unfortunately, the Contingent is still waiting on many dozens of application forms to be returned. It is absolutely essential that everyone is prompt in responding to these actions. Your assistance is very much appreciated in helping us to have all outstanding forms returned as a matter of urgency.

Thank you to those who emailed us with their Troop Preferences, we have done what we can to accommodate your requests. At the back of this newsletter you will find your troop allocation. For WSJ2019 the Australian Contingent has 60 patrols in 15 troops. Each patrol will have 8 or 9 youth members from around Australia with a mix of males and females, a mix of ages and experiences, and a mix of different states. Everyone will have the ability to meet new friends from around Australia, even before we arrive at the Jamboree site on our Pre-Tour in Washington DC.

Lloyd and I have been in contact with the Australian Embassy in Washington DC and they are working with us too to ensure our plans are well laid out, they have asked that this time we get a scanned copy of everyone's passports, just in case. In the Passport Section of the newsletter there are some instructions on what we need you to do.

No doubt everyone is keeping very busy with their fundraising still. I certainly know that the Contingent Team is working hard to ensure the preparations for our journey are well on track. Good luck with your own preparations and I shall look forward to sending the next update just before Christmas.

Flights & Passports

To travel to the United States with the Contingent you will need a current passport with an expiry date after 20 February 2020 as the USA requires entrants to have a passport with at least 6 months validity after the intended period of travel.

Currently we still have;

- 205 People who have not submitted their Passport Number and Expiry Date.
- 165 People who have submitted passport details with an expiry before the 20 February 2020, if this is **YOU**, please apply for a new Passport **NOW**.

Don't forget you can apply for a passport at <https://www.passports.gov.au> by completing the online form.

We require all Contingent members to have their passport details and a scanned copy in the application system by **COB Friday 21 December 2018**, This is very important as we need to put your name and passport number on the flight booking.

If you are planning on travelling to the jamboree on a passport other than an Australian Passport or if you are not an Australian citizen, please contact us immediately at passports@wsj2019.scouts.com.au so we can help you in applying for a VISA as you may not be eligible for an ESTA and ETA.

If you already have a passport that will expire before **20 February 2020**, please arrange to renew your passport. Note the visa/travel authorisation ESTA or ETA (see below for more information) are linked to your passport so if you apply for those on your existing passport and then get a new passport afterwards, the ESTA or ETA will no longer be valid. You must renew your passport before applying for the ESTA or ETA.

In discussions with the Australian Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT) we have been advised the Contingent should have a copy of everyone's Passport details page, this is in case of accidental loss/damage of a passport whilst travelling. Accordingly we request you scan your passport details page as a PDF document and upload it on the Travel Details page. If you will be travelling on two passports please ensure you load copies of both passports.

Visas & Travel Authorisations

All participants attending the Jamboree will need to complete an Electronic System for Travel Authorisation (ESTA) application for the USA and for those attending the post tour, an Electronic Travel Authorisation (ETA) for Canada. The Contingent requires you have your ESTA and, if applicable, ETA by December 2018.

These applications can only be done online, and only once you have your passport. If you are travelling on a passport other than an Australian passport, you may not be eligible for the ESTA or ETA visa waiver systems. Please contact us for more information if you are not travelling on an Australian passport.

Once you have your passport, please apply for your ESTA which is then valid for 2 years here: <https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov>. The cost for the ESTA is USD14.

Once you have been approved for the ESTA, please provide the reference number into the registration system (<https://registrations.international.scouts.com.au>) on the Travel Details page.

For those participating in the post tour into Canada, you also need to apply for an ETA which lasts for 5 years. You can apply for the ETA at <https://www.canadian-evisa.com> and it costs CAD7.00. You only need to apply for an ETA if you are doing the optional post Tour.

Uploading your Passport Scans

Contingent Shirts & Merchandise

As part of your contingent fee, you will receive 2x Short Sleeve Polo Shirts, 2 x Contingent Badges, 2x Contingent Bag Tags, 2x Scouts Australia International Scarfs, a Name Bar, a Drink Bottle, a Hat, a Backpack and a Travel Bag. You need to enter your sizing into the application system by **30 September 2018** so we can ensure we have your size available. To enter your size go to the T-Shirt/Hat tab.

Contingent Hats

The hats are sized and ordered by cm circumference of the wearer's head. The head is measured using a dress-makers tape, wrapped across the bare forehead and just above the ears. The measurement is rounded up to the next largest full cm: i.e. from a 57cm head measurement, a 58cm hat is initially selected for fitting.

Order the right size as there will be no ability to change your size, so make sure you take the right measurements.



Measuring Your Head

Place a measuring tape around your head, in centimeters if possible.
Try not to pull too tightly on the tape as you do not want the hat to sit too tightly on your head!

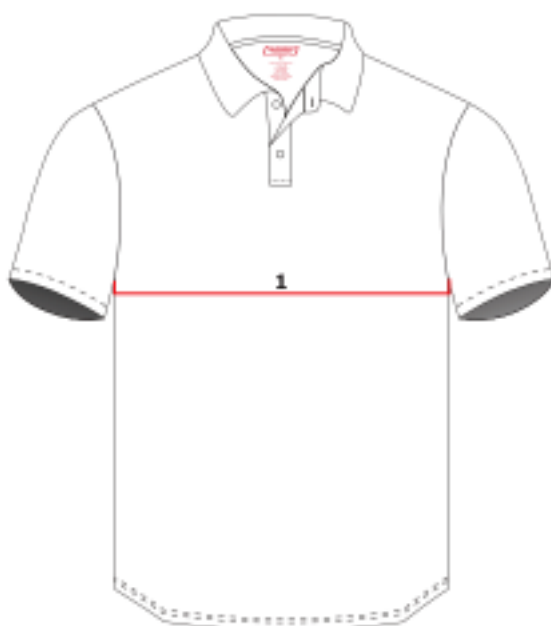

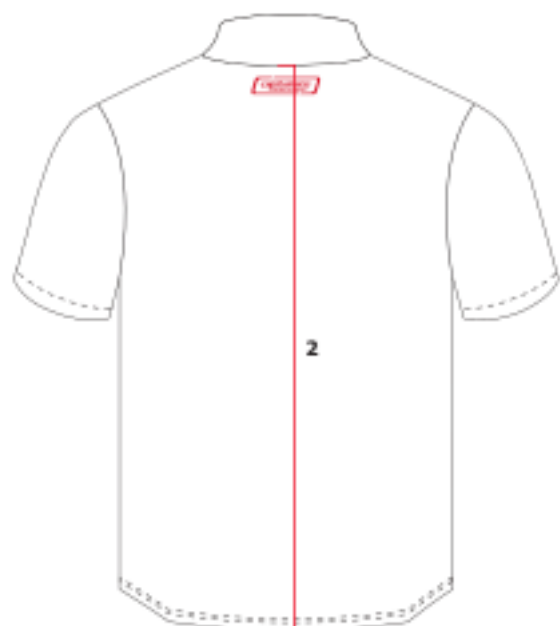
Grab an existing polo that is comfortable to wear. Lie it flat on a table or flat bench. Measure under arm pits to determine half chest – if polo chosen is 57 to 58cm they will be size large. Back length not as important. Measure just under collar to bottom hem.

Health and Welfare Information

We have created an amazing and experienced team of medical and welfare specialists to support you on this journey of a lifetime with close to 50,000 Scouts from all around the world. We will introduce you to the team in the next newsletter.

The USA has a very sophisticated health network and we will be working hard to ensure that we don't need to use it by understanding and carefully planning each of your individual health and welfare needs well in advance of the trip.

Our team has already started to work through the information that each of you have listed on your application form. It's been a while since you first applied and provided your details. We consider this "live" information and expect you to regularly go in and adjust it as things change with any medical, welfare or diet conditions you have. Please reach out to me directly rod.byrnes@wsj2019.scouts.com.au with any major changes you may wish to discuss.

If you have a medical condition or are taking a medication, please also add details regarding your treatment on the application. The medical tab has several sections you need to complete – remember to click on the '+' icon at the beginning of headings to add your information.

We would prefer no surprises, so please be open and honest about any conditions so we can provide the best care possible. Access to this information is **strictly** regulated and the team will respect your privacy.

Dietary Requirements

Thanks for listing your diet needs and please continue to monitor and keep it up to date. We will do our best to meet all needs presented and we are working diligently with the Jamboree organisers and the Pre- and Post-Tour accommodation providers. However, we will need confirmation from your medical practitioner for serious or life threatening conditions.

Health and Welfare Information

Fitness

I have personally visited the Jamboree site. The Summit Bechtel is huge and the only transport is “legpower”. That means you will need to be able to walk long distances on any given day and then back up again the next day and the next day...and there are hills! Did I mention it will be mid-summer and in the mid-thirties?

But don't stress too much yet. We are twelve months out so you have time to get your fitness up.

My recommendation is that you get your walking shoes on and set a goal of building up to 10,000 steps a day by 30 November. That's two months of effort. We'll follow up with the next stage of the fitness plan in the next newsletter.

The team is excited and we hope you are too.

Line Leader & IST Information

Adult members of the Australian Contingent serve the Jamboree in a number of important roles. Four adult leaders will be appointed to each Troop. Each of these line leaders will be assigned a specific patrol and will also assist the coordination of key responsibilities within their respective Troop.

About ninety adult members of the Australian Contingent will be attending the World Scout Jamboree as members of the International Service Team (IST) assisting to deliver the wide variety of activities on offer at this event. These activities include a myriad of essential roles that will ensure the Jamboree's success.

Over the coming months I will be liaising between the Australian IST members and the Jamboree Organising Committee to ensure, as much as possible, that each member's role is assigned prior to our arrival in the United States. More details will be forthcoming in future editions of each Australian Contingent Bulletin.

IST Job Catalogue

The Jamboree Organising Committee has recently published a catalogue of specific roles available for which members of the IST may apply. Please read through these roles carefully and enter your three preferences on the "ADDITIONAL INFORMATION" page of your application. This was due on **19 August 2018**, but unfortunately there are still 30 IST leaders who have not completed this task.

As part of the bulk upload process these preferences will be passed to the Jamboree organisers to guide them in determining your final role allocation. We hope to have confirmation of IST assignments before we depart for the United States. All enquiries about the IST roles should be sent directly to Harry at ist@wsj2019.scouts.com.au.

You may be contacted by the American Team Leader in the coming months, if they advise that you need to be on site earlier than 20 July 2019, please let them know that the Australian Contingent Leader (Shane) has reached an agreement with the Organisers that all our IST will be coming onsite on the afternoon of 20 July 2019.

Orientation Days

There are a number of important dates you should throw in your calendar now so that you don't miss out!

The Australian Contingent will be hosting a series of "O" Days around Australia on the dates listed here. Please note that we have added an additional "O" Day in Cairns. All Contingent gear will be issued to participants at these "O" Days, so it's mandatory that you attend!

Whilst it is mandatory, we understand that for some people this is not practical due to the long distances involved. We are investigating streaming one of the "O" Days, so that for those unable to attend they will still be able attend from the comfort of their own home.

Troop Allocations

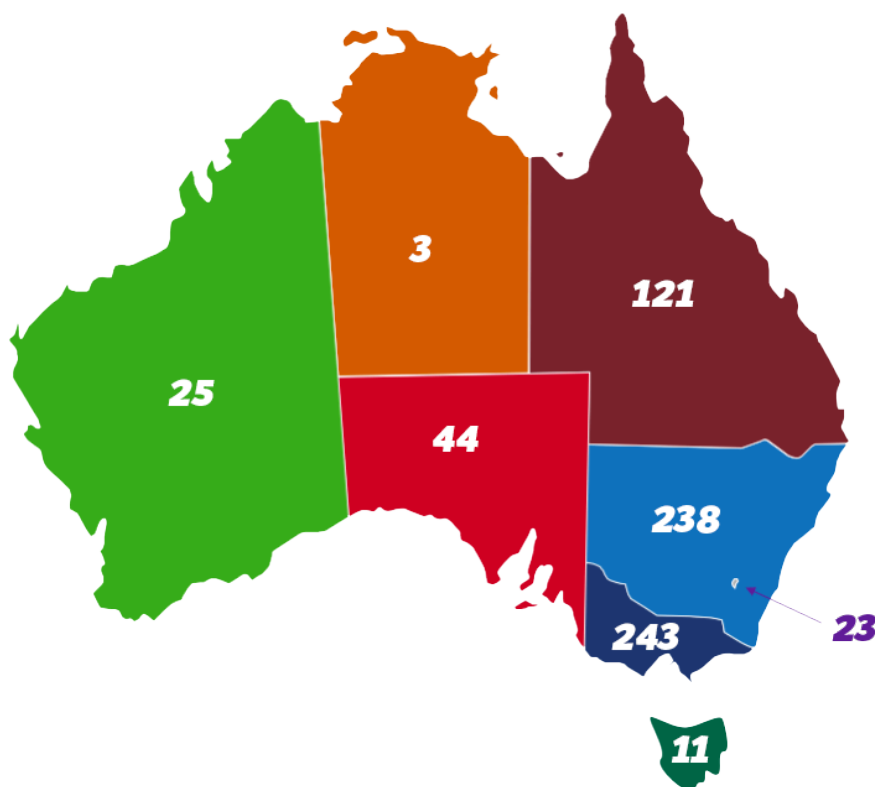
Last Newsletter we mentioned that we would be using the Venturer section terminology, unfortunately this was a little bit premature as the Jamboree Organisers have advised that we must use the Scout section terminology and structure. Therefore we have now reworked our 30 Units into 15 Troops, each with four leaders.

Each Troop will still run using Venturer methodology, with a Troop Chairman and a Troop Council managing the Troop. The Leaders will be there to assist, advise and mentor as required.

There will be four Patrols in each Troop consisting of 9 youth members and one Adult Leader (mentor). The following are all the troops and patrols with the associated Leader. One of the Leaders has been appointed as the Troop Leader who will be responsible for the implementation and running of the Troop Council.
